A meeting of all Learning Facilitators was held at CherYsh Resource Centre where they planned activities for the coming year. All the tablets have been serviced and repaired.

The Learning Facilitators have been oriented by experts from Meghshala Foundation. Most of our Learning Facilitators have expressed confidence in using the app as a teaching tool. A series of training sessions has been scheduled to enable the Learning Facilitators to use electronic medium as a teaching tool more efficiently.

Initial steps for Shiksha Phase 2

CherYsh plans to enter the second phase of Shiksha project in Year 2019-20. The focus will be on senior classes in this phase. Science, Technology and IT will be given importance. Twenty villages have been selected for the purpose. The phase 2 will be implemented in partnership with Deshpande Foundation, Hubballi.

We have shortlisted Learning Facilitators for the new Shikshas. Curriculum training is being planned in collaboration with the Deshpande Foundation. The first segment of training, which will be an intense week long residential session will be conducted in June at Hubballi.



Partnership to strengthen livelihood projects

CherYsh and Deshpande Foundation will join hands to sharpen the entrepreneurial skills of women in Haliyal and to scale up their livelihood ventures under the “Navodyami” programme.

The women entrepreneurs will be provided with marketing and networking opportunities under the programme. Mr. Sandeep Sabharwal and team from Deshpande Foundation visited CherYsh's

food and fabric. based livelihood projects in Haliyal a couple of times and discussed the future of the project with women entrepreneurs. In continuation to the same,

Ms. Renu Mukunda from CherYsh and the leadership of Deshpande Foundation also had several rounds of meetings to discuss and finalise the modalities of collaboration .
